**Format of Play**

**Mixed Team Championship**

The Mixed Team Championship shall be played in two stages: -

- a) **Group Stage (Qualifying Stage):** Round Robin within groups.
- b) **Knockout Stage (Final Stage):** Top Two (2) teams from each group will advance to the knockout stage in Quarter Finals, Semi-finals and finals.

**Draw of the knockout stage will be made after the completion of the last match of the Group Stage.**

Teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round in the knockout stage.

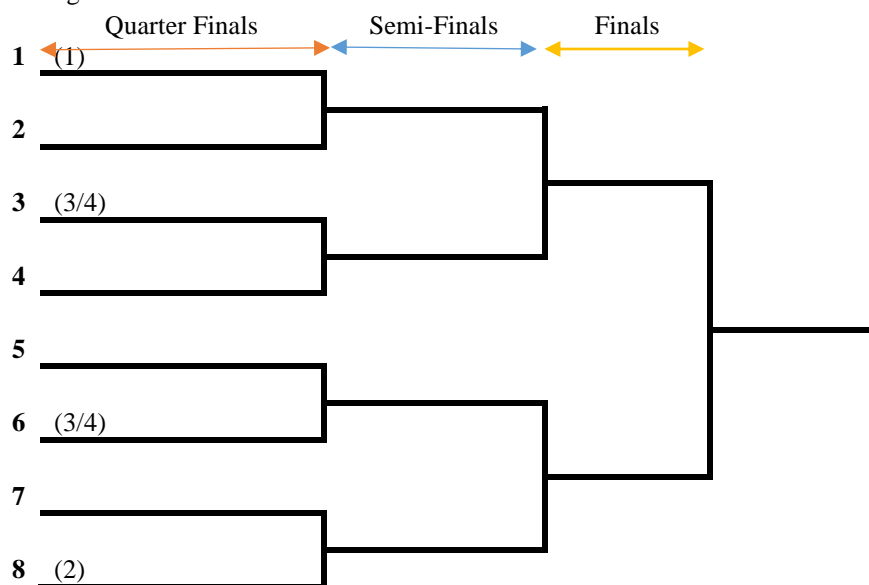

**Methodology of the Group Stage Draw**

1. If there are a total of 12 Teams, they will be drawn into 4 Groups (Group A, Group B, Group C, and Group D)
2. Draws shall be conducted by Badminton Asia.
3. The top 2 ranked teams shall be dealt with as follows:
  - No. 1 placed at the top of Group A
  - No. 2 placed at the top of Group D
4. The other ranked teams shall be dealt with as follows:

- No. 3 and No. 4 will be drawn by lot at the top of Group B and C
- No. 5 to 8 will be drawn by lot at the second position of the groups
- No. 9 to 12 will be drawn by lot at the third position of the groups.

#### **Knock Out Stage Draw's Methodology**

The Teams will be dealt with as follows:

- I.** Seed 1 will be placed in Positions 1 of the draw
- II.** Seed 2 will be placed in Position 8 of the draw
- III.** Seeds 3 and 4 will be drawn into Positions 3 and 6
- IV.** The remaining teams will be drawn into Positions 2, 4, 5, and 7 accordingly.
- V.** Teams from the same group will not be drawn to play in the First Round (Quarter Finals) in the knockout draw.

\* The teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round in the knockout stage.

#### **Individual Championships**

The Individual Championships shall be played in Full Knock Out Format will be used in all Individual Events using 3 x 21 Point Scoring System

#### **Important Note:**

- a) Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the number of groups and the size of each group for the Group Stage to be decided based on the number of participating teams.
- b) Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the size of the draw for the Knockout Stage accordingly based on the number of participating teams.
- c) Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the size of the draw for the Individual Championships accordingly based on the number of participating teams.
- d) Badminton Asia reserves the right for final decision for any matter related to the Championship.

#### **Seeding**

Seeding will be done by Badminton Asia based on BWF World Junior rankings. The date of the world ranking to be used will be in accordance with the dates stipulated in the **Key Dates** section.

Total Ranking Points of each event will be calculated based on the highest **BWF Junior Ranked** from the top player/s consisting of One top Men's Singles player, One top Women's Singles player, Two top Men's Doubles player, Two top Women's Doubles player, and Two top Mixed Doubles player (One Man, One Woman) from each member association, and seeding will be calculated by

comparing the total ranking points of each member to determine the overall strength of the team. An example of a Seeding Chart is given below :

In cases where there are rankings that are unavailable, the ranking points will be taken as zero.

- Mixed Doubles – Women's Singles – Men's Singles – Women's Doubles – Men's Doubles
- Women's Singles – Men's Singles – Women's Doubles – Men's Doubles – Mixed Doubles
- Men's Doubles – Women's Doubles – Men's Singles – Women's Singles – Mixed Doubles
