Nomination of Teams	Each competing Member Association shall nominate the number of players per team to Badminton Asia as follows: Teams are required to play ties comprising: Men's Team: Three men's singles Two men's doubles Women's Team: Three women's singles Two women's doubles Each team is required to nominate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not less than four (4) players • Not more than ten (10) players. Ranking order All players nominated shall be listed in order consistent with the World Rankings in singles. Players with no World Ranking shall be placed in the ranking order according to the current singles strength.

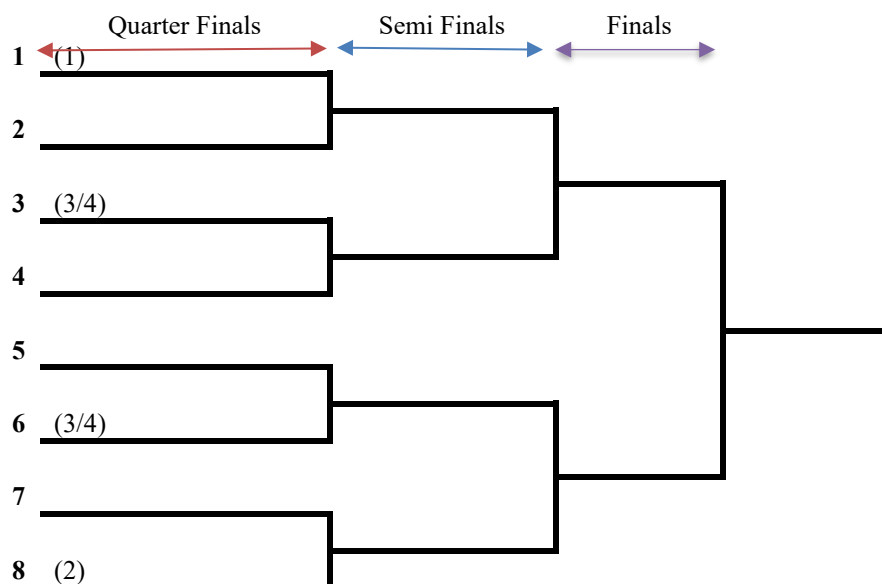
	<p>All pairs nominated shall be listed in order consistent with the World Rankings in doubles. Pairs with no World Ranking shall be placed in the ranking order according to the doubles' strength. To arrive at a final ranking order, the Referee will use the procedures in GCR Regulation 11.7 as applicable.</p>
Eligibility	<p>All Member Associations of Badminton Asia are entitled to take part.</p>

The online entry page will close immediately on the entry closing date at 23:59 hours, Badminton Asia Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All late submissions, including technical errors, will not be accepted. 2. No changes to the entries are allowed except for withdrawal after the entry deadline. 3. All entries MUST only be submitted through your Members Association. 4. Badminton Asia has the right to reject entries of any Member Associations if the entry is considered against the interest of the Championships and/or contains a condition unresolved by the entry deadline. 5. Badminton Asia has the right to reject entries of any Member Associations if they violate BWF Statutes GCR International Representation. <p>For members who are having technical difficulties, kindly contact Ms. Belle at belleng@badmintonasia.org before the entry deadline provided above.</p> <p>After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday (the next day of the group stage entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries.</p> <p>If no objection is received by Badminton Asia by the second day after the entries closing day, 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections shall be entertained after this point.</p>
Responsibility, Withdrawals & Penalties	<p>Every Member Association taking part in the Badminton Asia Team Championships shall be responsible for all expenses incurred by its players and officials, including travel, hotel accommodation, and other expenses.</p> <p>Withdrawal Penalty</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If a Member Association withdraws a team from the Championships after the entry deadline (By team) before the draw, for any reason whatsoever, such a Member Association shall automatically be penalized with an administrative fine of US\$1,000.00 per team. 2. If a Member Association withdraws a team from the Championships after the draw for any reason whatsoever, the Member Association shall automatically be penalized with an administrative fine of US\$3,000.00 per team. 3. If a Member Association fails to show up at the Championships (No Show) for any reason whatsoever, the Member Association shall automatically be penalized with an administrative fine of US\$5,000.00 per team. 4. If a team of a Member Association arrives late or departs early for any reason whatsoever and affects the team's ability to play or complete their scheduled matches or ties, such Member Association shall be penalized by an administrative fine of US\$1,500.00 per team. 5. If a medal-winning team of the Member Association is not present at the medal ceremony for any reason whatsoever, the Member Association shall be penalized by an administrative fine of US\$1,500.00 per team.

Constitution of Ties & Teams	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Each tie shall be decided by the results of three (3) singles and two (2) doubles matches. In the group stage, all five (5) matches of each tie shall be played. In the Knockout stage, each tie will be stopped when the tie is decided. In singles, each team shall play its three (3) players according to the nominated order of strength. In doubles, each team shall play its two (2) pairs according to the nominated order of strength. No player shall play more than one (1) singles and one (1) double match. 																																																											
Format of Play	<p>Badminton Asia Team Championships (Men's & Women's Team) shall be played in two stages:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Group Stage (Qualifying Stage): Round Robin within groups of four (4) Knock Out Stage (Final Stage): Top Two (2) teams from each group will advance to the knock-out stage in Quarter Finals, Semi-finals, and Finals. <p><u>A draw of the knockout stage will be made after the result of the Group Stage has been confirmed.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The condition of the draw is that the teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round of the knockout stage. - The Final position (top of each group) after the completion of the Group Stage will be used to determine a new seeding position for the Knock Out Stage. - The top-ranked teams of each group will be ranked in order of their strength in the manner described in clause 9 of BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.1 (Major Events Tournament Regulations Table) based on the seeding/ ranking date stated in the Key Dates. 4. The other ranked teams shall be dealt with as follows:

- No. 3 and No. 4 drawn by lot at the top of Groups B and C
- No. 5 to 8 drawn by lot at the second position of the groups
- No. 9 to 12 drawn by lot at the third position of the groups.

1.1 Knock Out Stage Draw's Methodology

The Teams will be dealt with as follows:

- I. Seed 1 and 2 will be placed in Positions 1 and 8
- II. Seed 3 and 4 will be drawn into Positions 3 and 6
- III. The remaining teams will be drawn into Positions 2, 4, 5, and 7 accordingly.
- IV. Teams from the same group will not be drawn to play in the First Round (Quarter Finals) in the knockout draw.

* The teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round in the knockout stage.

Important Note:

- Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the number of group(s) and the size of each group for the Group Stage & size of the Knock Out Stage Draw based on the number of participating teams.
- Badminton Asia reserves the right to move/redraw the teams when the group draw is deemed imbalanced after the draw due to team withdrawals (Example: 3, 3, 5, 4)
- Badminton Asia reserves the right to the final decision on any matter related to the championships.

Qualifying for the BWF Thomas & Uber Cup	<p>The top 4 (semi-finalists) teams from this Championships from each Men's and Women's Team Categories will qualify for the BWF Thomas and Uber Cups Finals.</p> <p>If the trophy holding and/or Host Member Association also takes part and occupies a qualifying position in its respective Continental stage, the next one or two highest-ranked teams (excluding above) from the World rankings in the same continent would also qualify.</p> <p><i>Note: Kindly refer to the BWF Statutes for Thomas and Uber Cups Regulations</i></p>

Seeding	<p>Seeding will be done by Badminton Asia based on the BWF World rankings. The date of the world ranking to be used will be in accordance with the dates stipulated in the Timeline above.</p> <p>Total Ranking Points of each category (Men's & Women's) will be calculated based on the three (3) highest-ranked singles players and two (2) Doubles pairs from each Member Association, and seeding will be calculated comparing the total ranking points of each Member Association to determine the overall strength of the team.</p> <p>In cases where the rankings are unavailable, the ranking points will be taken as zero.</p>		
Clothing & Advertising	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the competition regulations of the Badminton World Federation. (GCR 20 - 24)</p> <p>The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname, or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member count. (GCR 23.3)</p> <p><u>MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Name of player and Country/Team is MANDATORY from the first day of the event. 2. All participating teams must wear team colours from the first day of the event. That is, each player must wear the same colour and design of shirts and shorts (or equivalent articles of clothing) throughout a tie. 3. Opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colours.

Player's Obligation	<p>Media Obligations</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The players will be required to fulfil the media obligations as per BWF norms. 2.
