All entries <b>MUST</b> have BWF ID and submitted through your Members Association.</li> <li>5. Badminton Asia has the right to reject entries of any Member Associations, if entry is considered against the interest of the Championships and/or contains a condition unresolved by the entry deadline.</li> <li>6. <b>Age Eligibility</b>	<p>All Asian Member Associations are eligible</p> <p><b>*Under 19*</b></p> <p>All players must be under 19 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. <b>born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008</b>. The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. <b>born on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014</b>.</p>
<b>Events</b>	<p>Badminton Asia Junior Championships consist of: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Mixed Team Championship (<b>New Team Relay Format</b>)</li> <li>- Individual Championships (<b>3 x 21 Rally Point System</b>)</li> </ul>
<b>Entry Nomination for Mixed Team Championship</b>	<p>Each competing Member Association is able to make an online nomination which each team consist of:</p> <p><b><u>Numbers per Team</u></b></p> <p><b>Minimum: 4 Players (2 Males, 2 Females)</b></p> <p><b>Maximum: 20 Players (10 Males, 10 Females)</b></p> <p><b>Note</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Each player is allowed to play up to 3 matches in each set</li> <li>- <b>The same or different players can be nominated by the Team Manager to play in each set of a tie</b></li> <li>- No ranking is required during nominations.</li> <li>- <b>Prior start of a tie, each Team Manager shall hand to the referee within the time stipulated by the referee, the team composition for each set in the tie. ( Team Composition must specify players for all matches in each of three possible sets)</b></li> <li>- <b>If as a result of injury or illness sustained after arrival at the venue or during a tie, a team has only one male or one female player, that player may play in only two matches per set and the remaining matches in each set involving that player's gender shall conceded to the opposing side.</b></li> <li>- <b>If for the above reasons, the team is reduced to two players only, either both of same gender or one of each gender, the whole tie shall be conceded.</b></li> </ul> <p>Nominated players will compete in a <b>New Team Relay Format</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>New Team Relay Format = 3 sets x 55 Team Relay Points (NEW)</b></li> <li>- <b>Best of three (3) sets</b>, where a team that reaches <b>55 points</b> in a relay format wins a set</li> <li>- <b>A set is composed of 5 matches</b> comprising one of each event (<b>MS, WS, MD, WD, XD</b>)</li> </ul>

**Entry Nomination for Individual Championships**

The Individual Championships shall comprise of: -

- Men's Singles
- Women's Singles
- Men's Doubles
- Women's Doubles
- Mixed Doubles

Each Member Association will be entitled to enter a maximum of: -

**Constitution of Ties and Teams (Mixed Team Championships)**

**Constitution for Mixed Team Championship (New Team Relay Format)**

- New Team Relay Format = 3 Sets x 55 Team Relay Points (NEW)

- A Set shall be won by the side which first scores 55 Points

- Team who won **Best of three (3) sets** shall be the winner.

- Each Set shall consist of:

- One Men's Singles Match
- One Women's Singles Match
- One Men's Doubles Match
- One Women's Doubles Match
- One Mixed Doubles Match

**Each Tie**

1. The first match in a set starts at love all and ends when one side reaches 11 points
2. The second match in a set starts at the ending score of the first match and continues until a side's score reaches 22 points.
3. The third match in a set starts at the ending score of the second match and continues until a side's score reaches 33 points.
4. The fourth match in a set starts at the ending score of the third match and continues until a side's score reaches 44 points.
5. The fifth and final match in a set starts at the ending score of the fourth match and continues until a side's score reaches 55 points.
6. If the score becomes 54- all, the side who score the 55<sup>th</sup> point shall win the set.
7. Before play commences in the first match of a tie, a toss shall be conducted and the side winning the toss shall exercise the choice to serve or receive first.
8. The side leading at the end of a match shall serve first in the next match.
9. The side winning a set shall serve first in the next set.

### Retirement and Withdrawals

1. A player who retires or withdraws from a match due to injury, sickness, or other hindrance shall not play again in that tie. The player may however play in subsequent ties in the Tournament.
2. If a player/pair retires due to an injury or sickness, the match in progress shall be conceded in favour of the opponent. For example, if in the fourth match of a set of a tie between Team A and Team B, the player from Team A is injured and decides to retire when leading 38 – 33 then the match is awarded to Team B and the fifth match in the set starts with the score 44 – 38 in favour of Team B.
3. Once a tie has started, if a player withdraws due to injury, sickness or other unavoidable hindrance prior to starting a match, then that match shall be conceded in favour of the opponent. For example, if prior to the start of the second match of a set of a tie between Team A and Team B with Team A Leading 11 – 7, and the Team A player in the second match withdraws, the match will be then awarded to Team B and the third match in the set starts with score 22 – 11 in favour of Team B.

### Order of Play

-Two Team Managers shall meet with the referee at a time specified by the referee, to determine the order of play and the side of the court each time will play on in set 1.

-The order of play of the five matches (MS, WS, MD, WD, XD) once determined shall be the same in set 1, set 2 and set 3 (if required).

- The referee shall conduct a toss to determine which Team Manager chooses the first match in the order of play (“Order of Play Toss”).

- The Referee Team will also brief the teams again during Team Manager’s Meeting

### Withdrawals ( Teams and Individual Event)

Withdrawals for Teams after the Team Nomination deadline and for Individuals after the Players Nomination deadline must be informed by an e-mail to [belleng@badmintonasia.org](mailto:belleng@badmintonasia.org) and the tournament referee **Mr. Au Man-Fung Simon (HKG)** E-mail: [simon.au.hk@outlook.com](mailto:simon.au.hk@outlook.com) as soon as possible.

- Withdrawals before the tournament must be accompanied by an appropriate certification.
- Withdrawals after **Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> June 2026**, will be processed in the Team Managers’ Meeting.
- Withdrawals after the draw is made due to illness or injury must be supported by a medical certificate.

- Withdrawals after players arrive in the venue city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager to the Referee in writing.
- Withdrawals after the last day of withdrawal without penalty may result in a penalty.

**Format**

**Mixed Team Championship (New League Format)**

The Mixed Team Championship shall be played in two stages: -

- Group Stage (Qualifying Stage):** Round Robin within groups.
- Knock Out Stage (Final Stage):** Top Two (2) teams from each group will advance to the knockout stage in Quarter Finals, Semi-finals and finals.

**The draw for the Knock Out Stage will be made after the completion of the last match of the Group Stage.**

Teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round of the Knock Out Stage.

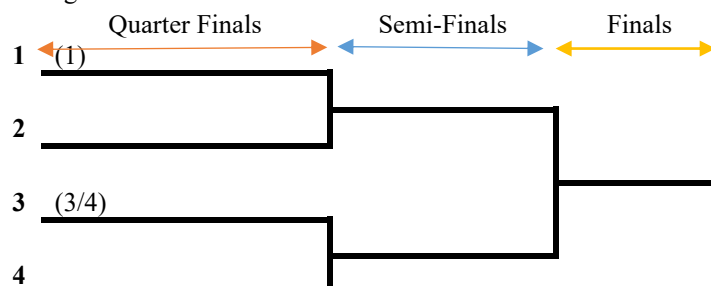

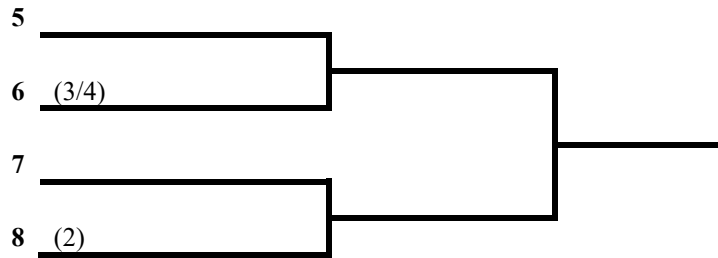

**Methodology of the Group Stage Draw**

- If there are a total of 12 Teams, they will be drawn into 4 Groups (Group A, Group B, Group C, and Group D)
- Draws shall be conducted by Badminton Asia.
- The top 2 ranked teams shall be dealt with as follows:
  - No. 1 placed at the top of Group A
  - No. 2 placed at the top of Group D
- The other ranked teams shall be dealt with as follows:
  - No. 3 and No. 4 will be drawn by lot at the top of Groups B and C
  - No. 5 to 8 will be drawn by lot at the second position of the groups
  - No. 9 to 12 will be drawn by lot at the third position of the groups.

**Knock Out Stage Draw's Methodology**

The Teams will be dealt with as follows:

- I. Seeds 1 and 2 will be placed in Positions 1 and 8
- II. Seeds 3 and 4 will be drawn into Positions 3 and 6
- III. The remaining teams will be drawn into Positions 2, 4, 5, and 7 accordingly.
- IV. Teams from the same group will not be drawn to play in the First Round (Quarter Finals) in the Knock Out draw.

\* The teams from the same group shall not be drawn to meet in the first round of the Knock Out Stage.

**Individual Championships**

The Individual Championships Full Knock Out Format will be used in all Individual Events using **3 x 21 Rally Point System**.

**Important Note:**

- a) Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the number of groups and the size of each group for the Group Stage based on the number of participating teams.
- b) Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the size of the draw for the Knock Out Stage accordingly, based on the number of participating teams.
- c) Badminton Asia reserves the right to determine the size of the draw for the Individual Championships accordingly, based on the number of participating teams.
- d) Badminton Asia reserves the right for final decision for any matter related to the Championship.

**Seeding**

Seeding will be done by Badminton Asia based on the BWF World Junior rankings. The date of the world ranking to be used will be in accordance with the dates stipulated in the **Key Dates** section.

Total Ranking Points of each event will be calculated based on the highest **BWF Junior Ranked** from the top player/s of One Men's Singles, One Women's Singles, Two Men's Doubles, Two Women's Doubles, and Two Mixed Doubles (One Men, One Women) from each Member Association, and seeding will be calculated by comparing the total ranking points of each member to determine the overall strength of the team. An example of a Seeding Chart is given below :

In cases where rankings are unavailable, the ranking points will be treated as zero.
