Substitution	➤ After the closing date for entries, a player who has entered may be unable to take part through illness, injury, or other unavoidable cause. That player's place in singles or doubles or both may be taken by a player who has already entered another Badminton Asia Senior Championships event, provided the provisions regarding maximum number of entries in Age Eligibility & Entry Quota are respected. ➤ If there is a withdrawal of player and the respective Member has not requested for a substitute, such player, should he/she agree to the partner, should be granted a partner from the “partner wanted” list, and this should only be done until the publication of the draw. ➤ After the publication of the draw, substitutions are only allowed to be made until the end of the Team Managers’ Meeting. no other changes or substitutions of any kind can be made after the Team Managers Meeting accept for withdrawal. ➤ If two Players from two different pairs in the same Event are put together, the placement of the new pair shall be at the position of the pair seeded in the highest seeding group.
