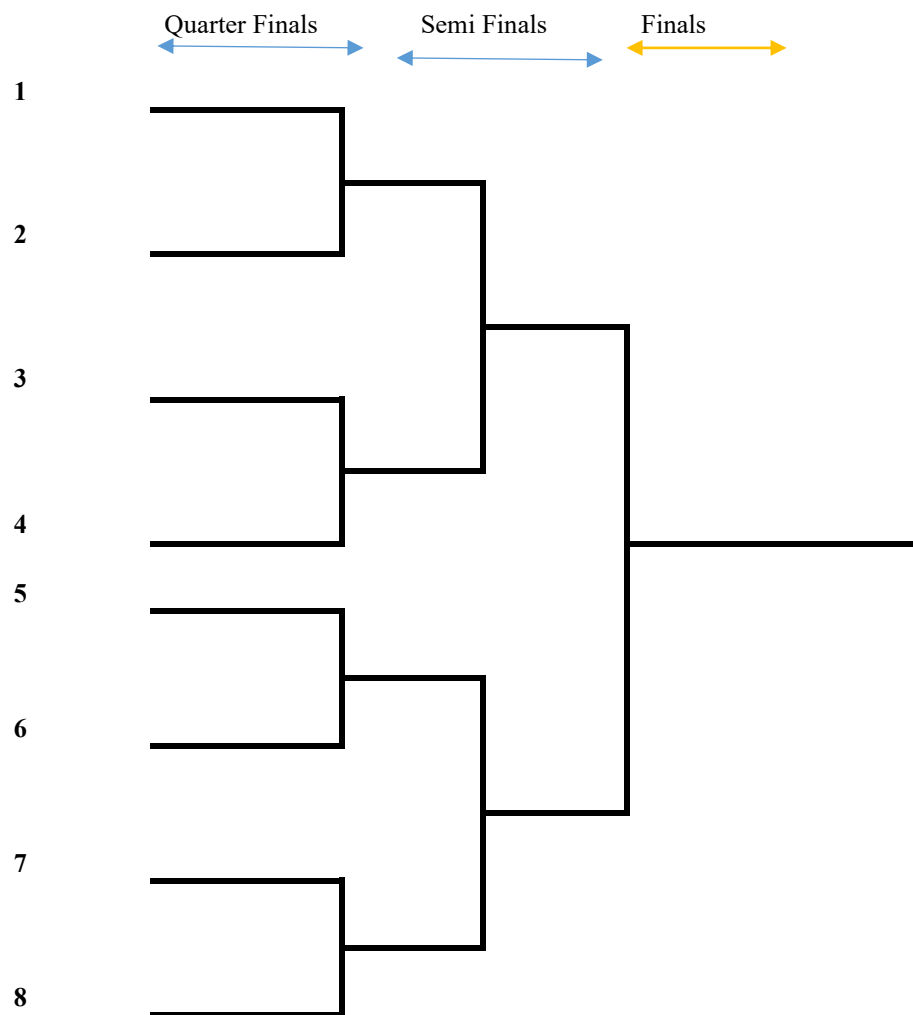

No changes to the entries are allowed except for withdrawal after the entry deadline. 4. All entries MUST only be submitted through your Members Association. 5. Badminton Asia has the right to reject entries of any Member Associations, if entry is considered against the interest of the Championships and/or contains a condition unresolved by the entry deadline. 6. Badminton Asia has the right to reject entries of any Member Associations, if it violates BWF STATUTES GCR 6: International Representations For members who are having technical difficulties, kindly contact Mr Ian at ipienzenaves@badmintonasia.org before the entry deadline provided above. After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following close of entries. If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday (second day after the entries closing day) 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.

	b) Knock Out Stage (Final Stage): Top Two (2) teams from each group will advance to the knock out stage in Quarter Finals, Semi-finals and finals: Best of Three (3) shall win the tie

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Group Stage Draw's Methodology

1. Team of 6 will be Drawn into 2 Groups (Group A, Group B)
2. Draws shall be conducted by Badminton Asia.
3. Top 2 ranked teams shall be dealt with as follows:
 - I. Seed No. 1 placed at the top of Group A
 - II. Seed No. 2 placed at the top of Group D
 - III. Seed No 3 & 4 will be drawn into the top position of B & C
4. The other ranked teams shall be randomly drawn into the remaining positions.
5. Top 2 from each group will automatically be promoted into the Final Stage

Under 23 All players must be under 23 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2004.The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2014. *Under 19* All players must be under 19 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2008.The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2014. *Under 16* All players must be under 16 years old throughout the calendar year of the tournament. i.e. born on or after 1st January 2011.The minimum age for all players shall be 12 years old, i.e. born on or before 31st December 2014. All players MUST have a BWF Player’s ID before submission of the entries. Players with no BWF ID must contact their National Association Accordingly. All players MUST be the passport holder of the represented countries. All players MUST meet the eligible age stated above. *IMPORTANT NOTE* - Players are allowed to participate in a maximum of 3 events for each Team & Individuals (1 Singles, 1 Doubles, 1 Mixed) - Players are not allowed to play in the same event of different age group Example: - If Player A participate in Under 19 MS, he is not allowed to participate in Under 16 MS - If Player A participate in Under 19 MS, Players are allowed to participate in Under 16 MD and/or Under 16 XD, so long as the age eligibility has been met. - For Players whom does not meet any of the requirements above, Badminton Asia had a right to immediately remove the player from participation

Clothing & Advertising	Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the competition regulations of Badminton World Federation. (GCR 20 - 24) The player's name on the back of clothing shall be identical with the name registered as the Last Name (or an abbreviation thereof) in the BWF Player database. Last Name is defined as the family name, surname or similar name under the respective naming protocol of the Member count. (GCR 23.3) <u>RECOMMENDED CLOTHING REGULATIONS</u> 1. Name of player and Member is MANDATORY from the first day of the event. 2. All participating teams must wear team colours. That is, each player must wear the same colour and design of shirts and shorts (or equivalent articles of clothing) throughout a tie. 3. Opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colours. 4. It's Mandatory for doubles partners to wear pair shirts.
